## \$1/week (\$52/year):

## \$10/week (\$520/year):

- Backpacks filled with school supplies for 10 students from limited income families.
- 7 weeks of extra child care support for children with special needs.
- Community-based learning opportunities for 11 high school students.

## \$20/week (\$1040/year):

- Training and support for 10 Volunteer Readers in elementary classrooms.
- A Born Learning Trail for use by a community's young children and their caregivers.
